Why Participate in Church Activities?

Scripture references:

I Corinthians 12:12-27

Ephesians 4:11-26

James 2:14-26

COVID is winding down and there are efforts to “return to normal”. I think we can agree that normal will most likely look a little different. We will re-examine our lives. We will think about what is important and what is not. We will think about how we allot our time. The following is something for you to think about as you decide what your “normal” will look like.

God designed us for relationships. Think Adam and Eve. We are designed for relationships with others and with Him.

In a 2018 article from Christianity Today we find the following:

Spirituality and faith are one of the most influential things in your life. No matter what religion you choose to follow, it is important to be surrounded by others who have the same beliefs as you. Increasing your involvement in church can help strengthen relationships with people who share similar values and ways of life.

Communion with other Christians is very important in growing our faith.

1 Corinthians 12:12-17 talks about each of us being a part of the body of Christ. Corinthians specifically talks about how the body would be unable to function properly if a part were missing or tried to be a part that they were not designed for.

Ephesians 4:11-12 reminds us that we each have a gift suitable for building up the body of Christ. Here at FCCB we are a body of Christ. Each of us plays a part in how we as a church, carry out God's plan. Each of us has a specific skill or ability that we bring to FCCB.

James 2:14-26 tells us that “Faith without works is dead”. Are you looking to spend your time in a way that will grow your faith? Daily Bible reading, regular prayer, Sunday Worship attendance, trying to live the fruits of the Spirit are definitely a do. But many of us forget that participation in the work is also important. The web site Quora.com asked the question “Why would you participate in Church activities?”. All respondents stated that participation in church activities helped them grow their faith.

One Church goer made the following analogy:

“Finally, as I think about participating in church activities, I am reminded of the coals on a grill. The coals, when they are together, remain hot and can provide the needed heat to warm an area or to cook. The coals as a group, do what they are meant to do. Pull one of the coals to the side, away from all the others and soon it will lose its heat. People are like that too”.

I will close with her final statement which sums up the whole thing.

“When together we grow in our abilities, faith and commitment. Alone, we struggle. The church offers me a group through which my faith is validated”.

I am looking forward to seeing you beyond worship services.

Meeting 06/23/21 – Oceanfront Classroom, 10:00 am

Members Present: Mike Snyder, Kristin Jewell, Ed Washburn, Scott Kelly, Bob Meador, Nathan Loewen and John Jolly

Opening Prayer: Kristin Jewell

- Motion made by Scott and seconded by Ed, to accept last meeting's minutes; all were in favor.
- **Financial Report** – John reported we are in good financial shape. It was noted that we are beginning to hire additional staff and we will want to watch our budget – however, we have budgeted for this staff and expect for the finances to be in line.
- **Building & Grounds** – Ed is planning a workday at FCCB. Sylvia Osewalt is his new contact, and they will collaborate on timing and make an announcement to the congregation for volunteers when decided.
Our cleaning crew had been slow to bill for their services – he has brought this to their attention, and it has been corrected with timely billing to follow.
Our new parttime maintenance man is beginning to settle in. If you know of any maintenance issues, please let Ed know.
- **Scott** reported on the state of our sound/media equipment. We are now up to date. A Microsoft OneDrive document site is being worked on for general documents, that multiple people need to have access to – this should be completed in a week or two.
- **Mike** gave an update on our search committee for a Youth Director and Executive Pastor. John Madison has accepted our offer of employment and will be joining us in late July as our new Director of Student Ministries. The Executive Pastor position has been narrowed down to 6 strong candidates. Hopefully, we will have a decision by late summer or early fall.
- **Youth House** - Bob gave an update.... we are currently \$218,000.00 short for the building, not including furnishings and materials. It was noted that donations are still trickling in, but that we have a way to go.
- **Mike** addressed our Memorial Funds account. In an effort to put these dollars to good use, Scott motioned that all the undesignated funds be moved to the Youth Building Campaign Account. That motion was seconded by Ed, all were in favor. There are still dollars in the Memorial Account that are designated funds and will be used when appropriate.
- **Kristin** reported on the bank Club Checking Account balance. All accounts are in expected order.
- No new business was discussed.

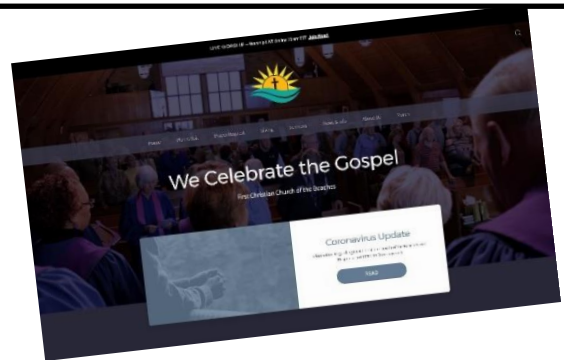
